Institute donates sweaters and blankets 5000 people every year in winter session. ROTI-SEVA- for poor people every 15 days. institute also conducts mobile diagnostic centres 25 villages in around and Garhwa.

Qualitative analysis of Criterion 4



The institute provided the good infrastructure that caters to the needs of students, faculty and patients to offer the finest patient care and technological resources., Medical facility of two medical centres with 24x7 residential doctors and staff nurses.
